

Introduction

The following pages contain the answer key to the seven lesson Bible correspondence course, *Seeking the Truth.* All quotations from Scripture are from the New King James Version.

When a student answers a question incorrectly, make sure to supply him with the correct answer and an explanation as to why it is correct. The purpose of the course is not to be the grade achieved but rather for the student to come to an understanding of what he is to know, believe and do in relation to his soul's salvation.

Keep your explanations simple and back them up with Scripture. Always remember our teachings must rest upon the inspired word of God.

A Bible correspondence course can be an effective tool to bring people to Christ. At the Centerville Road congregation in Tallahassee, Florida, we have found a number of ways to distribute it. However you use it, pray that the gospel message might touch the hearts of those who need salvation and that in all things God will be glorified.


